Overview:

Organisations are conducting an increasing array of internal audits to ensure various stakeholder needs are being addressed in an effective manner. A number of these audits can have overlapping objectives leading to duplication and inefficient use of resources. A common response has been to integrate related management systems, none more so than in the area of environment, health & safety (EHS).
